ABOUT

The Woodside Resident Glass Program is a trial program that has been set-up to compensate homeowners for glass damage caused by errant golf balls. Registration in the program provides Woodside Community Residents with replacement of windows damaged by the unintentional impact of an errant golf ball. Woodside Golf Course Inc. manages all claims associated with this program so that homeowners are not faced with trying to recoup damages from golfers.

As mentioned above, the Resident Glass Program is a trial program that can be terminated at any time. In the event that the program is terminated, all residents registered with the program will be notified 30 days in advance.

To be eligible for the program, you must submit photos of the glass (windows and deck panels) that make up your home. Please note that Woodside Golf Course Inc. will repair your glass only if it was broken by a golf ball, during the Woodside operating season. All glass will be replaced with the same or a similar product.

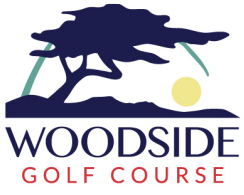
Please label your photo(s) with your name, address and the hole that you reside on.

The accompanying waiver form has been redrafted for clarity. The waiver will be required to be completed and forwarded to info@woodsidegc.com when an incident occurs. If you don't have email, you can drop the waiver form off with the Pro Shop or Office team.

We would also ask that you call 403.948.6717 and report your glass damage to us. Should the office be closed, please leave a message in our general delivery mailbox and we will process your claim at our earliest opportunity.

To enroll in the program, you must complete the application form fully and submit it along with dated photos of all the windows and deck glass in your home. These pictures should show the glass in your home in perfect condition. Please include your name and address on the back of all photos submitted. These items should be delivered by one of the following means:

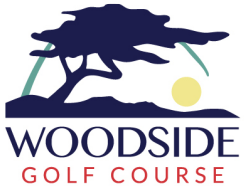
